This new services means it will be possible to print a three-dimensional design - which will have to be provided in an STL file - of an object, or make 'Mini Me' replicas by scanning a person's own body.

The 3D prints can be made in plastic (ABS), paper, flexible (rubber), transparent (acrylic) or ceramic. The price of the service depends on the object to be printed and the printing material.

Customers can opt to collect their 3D piece from the Vasco da Gama Worten store or at any address they give, if the 3D printing is based on a three dimensional drawing.
